

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

TRAFFIC SIGNS (PARKING BAYS) AUTHORISATION 1998

Coming into Operation: 13th March 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 15 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following authorisation is hereby given:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This instrument may be cited as the Traffic Signs (Parking Bays) Authorisation 1998 and shall come into force on the 13th March 1998

(2) In this instrument -

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985.

Authorisation of traffic sign (road marking)

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the Department of Transport authorises the placing in the roads specified in Schedule 1 (being roads having a carriageway width of not less than 7 metres but not more than 8.5 metres to which section 18(2) of the Road Traffic Act 1985(b) applies) of a traffic sign consisting of the marking specified in diagram 1032 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1994 (c), as they have effect in the Island by virtue of the Traffic Signs (No 2) Regulations 1995 (d), with the substitution of the minimum dimensions indicated in the drawing shown in Schedule 2.

(2) The traffic sign referred to in paragraph (1) may not be placed except to indicate a parking place which, by virtue of an order under section 14 of the Act, is designated for use only by a vehicle the overall width of which does not exceed 1.7 metres or any lesser width or in excess of 2.7 metres in width specified in the order.

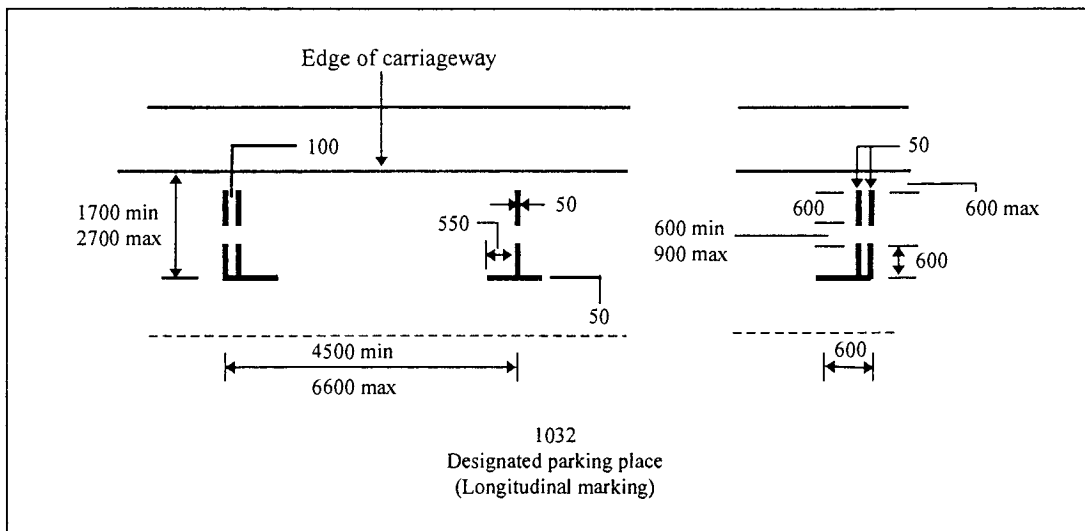

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Instrument)

This instrument authorises under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 the placing on the roads specified in the Schedule (in respect of which an on-street parking order is made under Section 14 of the Act) a road marking laying out parking bays suitable only for vehicles which do not exceed 1.7 metres overall width or are in excess of 2.7 metres in width.
