**PEEL ROAD (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 1998**

Coming into operation: 16th March 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Peel Road (Douglas) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Monday 16th March 1998

One-Way Traffic

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a westerly direction over Peel Road, Douglas from its junction with Athol Street to its junction with Hope Street.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until Friday 15th May 1998.

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in a westerly direction only over Peel Road, Douglas, whilst resurfacing work is being undertaken.
