ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (REGENT STREET)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF DISABLED PARKING PLACES) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation : 18th March 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Regent Street) (Temporary Suspension of Disabled Parking Places) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Wednesday 18th March 1998

Temporary suspension of parking

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked in the disabled bays on the northside of Regent Street, Douglas adjacent to the Post Office.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until Tuesday 15th September 1998 or until the building work in Duke Street is completed whichever is the earlier.
