



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**U39 GAREY ROAD (ONCHAN)
(WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation: 8th April 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the U39 Garey Road (Onchan) (Weight Restriction) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on 8th April 1998

Weight restriction

2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the laden and unladen weight of which, exceeds 2 tonnes to proceed on the U39 Garey Road from its junction with the A2 Douglas to Ramsey Road to its junction with the B20 Begoade Road in the Parish of Onchan.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used :-

- (a) in exercise of its function as a fire brigade, ambulance or police vehicle;
- (b) such other exemptions as to the occasional use that the Department may authorise in writing.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to impose a weight restriction on vehicles exceeding 2 tonnes in weight laden or unladen from using the U39 Garey Road from its junction with the A2 Douglas to Ramsey Road to its junction with the B20 Begoade Road in the Parish of Onchan.
