ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (PEEL ROAD)  
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF NO WAITING RESTRICTIONS) ORDER 1998**

*Coming into Operation : 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1998*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made :-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Peel Road) (Temporary Suspension of No Waiting Restrictions) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1998.

**Temporary suspension of no waiting restrictions**

2. The provisions of entry No 33 (a) (Peel Road) of the Traffic Regulations Consolidation Order (b) made by Douglas Corporation as it relates to the north side of Peel Road from its junction with St Georges Walk to its junction with Hope Street shall be suspended.

**Duration**

3. This Order shall continue in force until Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> April 1998 or until the reconstruction work on Peel Road is completed whichever shall be the earlier.
