ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (ONE-WAY STREETS)
(AMENDMENT) (NO 1) ORDER 1998**

Coming into Operation: 29th May 1998

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (One-Way Streets) (Amendment) (No 1) Order 1998 and shall come into operation on the 29th May 1998

Amendment of principal Order

2. The One-Way Traffic Streets Order 1981 (b) made by the Douglas Corporation shall be further amended by the insertion of the following entry :-

“77 Unnamed lane between Regent Street to Southerly”
Regent Street and Fort Street Fort Street

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to impose a one-way traffic system on the unnamed lane between Regent Street and Fort Street in the Borough of Douglas which will require traffic to travel in a southerly direction only.
