



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (NORTH QUAY)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2000**

Coming into Operation : 24th January 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (North Quay) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 2000 and shall come into operation at 6.00 am on Monday 24th January 2000.

One-Way Traffic

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in an easterly direction over North Quay Douglas from its junction with Bank Hill to its junction with Quine's Corner, Douglas.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 8.00 pm on Sunday 13th February 2000 or until the work on North Quay is completed whichever is the earlier

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in an easterly direction only over North Quay, Douglas whilst sewer repairs work is being undertaken.
