



**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985**  
**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (HILL STREET)**  
**(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2000**

*Coming into Operation: 6<sup>th</sup> March 2000*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made:-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (North Quay) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 2000 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2000.

**One-Way Traffic**

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a westerly direction over Hill Street Douglas from its junction with Prospect Hill to its junction with Upper Church Street, Douglas.

**Duration**

3. This Order shall continue in force until 8.00 p.m. on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> August 2000.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in a westerly direction only over Hill Street, Douglas.
