



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**OLD CASTLETOWN ROAD (BRADDAN) OAKHILL  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2002**

*Coming into Operation: 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2002*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Old Castletown Road (Braddan) Oakhill (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2002 and shall come into operation at 9.00 a.m. on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2002.

**Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed on Old Castletown Road in the Parish of Braddan at the Oakhill Railway Bridge.

**Exemptions**

3. Article 2 does not apply to -

(1) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or

(2) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

4. The Order shall continue in force until Sunday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2002 or until the Iris works are completed whichever is the earlier.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding on a section of Old Castletown Road, Braddan whilst the Iris works take place.

An alternative route will be via the B23 Port Soderick Road and the A37 Marine Drive, Keristal.
