THE POLICE ACT 1993

The Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations 2002

Laid before Tynwald

19th February 2002

Coming into operation in accordance with Regulation 1(2)

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by section 8 of the Police Act 1993(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Chief Constable and the Isle of Man Police Federation, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Isle of Man Police (Amendment) Regulations 2002.

(2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have had effect from 1st November 2000.

(3) In these Regulations "the principal Regulations" means the Isle of Man Police Regulations 2000(b).

Amendment of regulation 53 (removal allowance)

2. (1) After regulation 53(3) of the principal Regulations there shall be inserted -

"(3A) Where a member of a police force in the United Kingdom moves his home in consequence of his voluntarily transferring from that force to the police force, otherwise than in circumstances to which paragraph (2) applies, the Department -

- (a) may either reimburse the reasonable cost of removal or carry out the removal;
- (b) may, in the circumstances mentioned in paragraph (1)(b), reimburse the expenses there mentioned;
- (c) may, in the circumstances and subject to the conditions mentioned in paragraph (1)(c), reimburse the expenses there mentioned;
- (d) may, subject to the conditions mentioned in paragraph (1)(d), reimburse the expenses there mentioned."

(2) In paragraph (4) of regulation 53 of the principal Regulations, after the words "under paragraph (1)" there shall be inserted the words "or (3A)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Isle of Man Police Regulations 2000 and will be backdated to come into effect on 1st November 2000. Removal allowances have been paid to Police Officers who transfer to the Isle of Man Constabulary from other Police Forces previously under regulation 53 of the Police Regulations. The amendments will allow for a dedicated provision to cover removal allowances paid to transferring Officers.
