## THE SUPERANNUATION ACT 1984

### THE JUDICIAL PENSION (AMENDMENT) SCHEME 2002

*Approved by Tynwald*

20<sup>th</sup> March 2002

*Coming into operation*

1st April 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Civil Service Commission by section 1 of the Superannuation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, the following Scheme is hereby made:—

#### 1. Citation and commencement

This Scheme may be cited as the Judicial Pension (Amendment) Scheme 2002 and, subject to section 12(1) of the Superannuation Act 1984, shall come into operation on the 1st April 2002.

#### 2. Amendment of 1992 Scheme

(1) In clause 2(1) of the Judicial Pension Scheme 1992<sup>2</sup>, after "Second Deemster" insert —

"Deputy Deemster".

(2) The Schedule to the said Scheme is amended in accordance with the Schedule to this Scheme.

SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS OF SCHEDULE TO 1992 SCHEME

1. In paragraph 2, in the table, for "a High Bailiff or Deputy High Bailiff" substitute "a Deputy Deemster, High Bailiff or Deputy High Bailiff".
2. In paragraph 7, in section 7A(1), in the definition of "20-year office", for "High Bailiff or Deputy High Bailiff" substitute "Deputy Deemster, High Bailiff or Deputy High Bailiff".
3. In paragraph 11, for the second item in the table substitute —

"Deputy Deemster, High Bailiff or Deputy High Bailiff"	Service as Deputy Deemster, High Bailiff or Deputy High Bailiff"

4. In paragraphs 39 and 44, in the substituted Schedule 2, after "Deemster" insert —

"Deputy Deemster".
