



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

TOWN OF RAMSEY (SPEED LIMITS) (VARIATION) (NO 1) ORDER 2002

Coming into Operation: 17th June 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Town of Ramsey (Speed Limits) (Variation) (No1) Order 2002 and shall come into effect on 17th June 2002.

Variation of speed limit

2. The limit of speed fixed by Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 for driving a motor vehicle on roads within the Town of Ramsey shall, in respect of the length specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Order, be the speed specified opposite thereto in the second column of that Schedule.

SCHEDULE

Column 1	Column 2
<u>Length of Road</u>	<u>Limit of Speed</u>
1. The entire length of Vernon Road (including all roads within housing estates leading from this road)	20 mph
2. The entire length of Prince's Road (including all roads within housing estates leading from this road)	20 mph
3. The entire length of Glen Elfin Road (including all roads within housing estates leading from this road)	20 mph

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to impose a 20 mph speed limit on the entire length of the following roads within the Ramsey Town Boundary:-

1. Vernon Road)
(including Elfia Court))
2. Prince's Road) including all roads within housing estates leading from these roads
(including Laurys Avenue))
3. Glen Elfin Road)
