



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (BARRACK STREET/CHURCH STREET)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2002**

Coming into operation: 18th February 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Barrack Street/Church Street) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 2002 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday 18th February 2002.

One-Way Traffic

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed in an easterly direction only over the whole of Barrack Street, Douglas and in a northerly direction only on that section of Church Street from Barrack Street to, but not including, its junction with Shaws Brow, Douglas.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 28th June 2002 or until the construction work is completed.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in an easterly direction only over Barrack Street and a northerly direction only over a section of Church Street, Douglas.
