

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**RURAL ROADS (SPEED LIMITS) (AMENDMENT) (NO 2) ORDER 2002**

*Coming into Operation : - 20<sup>th</sup> March 2002*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made:-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Rural Roads (Speed Limits) (Amendment) (No ) Order 2002 and shall come into operation on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2002.

**Amendment of principal Order**

2. The Rural Roads (Speed Limits) Order 1979 (b) shall be further amended so as to have effect in accordance with the following provisions of this Order.

**Imposition of speed limits**

3. In Schedule 2 (Limits of Speed) after paragraph 1 (Parish of Andreas) insert the following entry:-

“(o)	The Sulby Bridge/Bride Road (A17)	
(i)	from St Judes crossroads southwards for a distance of 210 metres	30
(ii)	from a point 210 metres south of St Judes crossroads southwards for a distance of 290 metres	40
(iii)	from St Judes crossroads northwards for a distance of 165 metres	30
(iv)	from a point 165 metres north of St Judes crossroads eastwards for a distance of 250 metres	40



- (p) The Ramsey to Cronk Road (A13)
- (i) from St Judes crossroads eastwards for a distance of 135 metres 30
  - (ii) from a point 135 metres east of St Judes crossroads eastwards for a distance of 300 metres 40
  - (iii) from St Judes crossroads westwards for a distance of 155 metres 30
  - (iv) from a point 155 metres west of St Judes crossroads westwards for a distance of 250 metres 40"
