**THE MAINTENANCE ORDERS (RECIPROCATING COUNTRIES)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2002**

Coming into operation

1st March 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Ministers by section 1(1) of the Maintenance Orders (Reciprocal Enforcement) Act 1995¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Maintenance Orders (Reciprocating Countries) (Amendment) Order 2002 and shall come into operation on the 1st March 2002.

2. Amendment of principal Order

In Schedule 1 to the Maintenance Orders (Reciprocating Countries) Order 1996², at the end insert —

"The following
provinces and territories
of Canada:

Nunavut

1st March
2002

Maintenance orders other than —

- (a) affiliation orders;
- (b) maintenance orders of the description contained in section 18(2)(b) of the 1995 Act; and
- (c) orders obtained by or in favour of a public authority".
