



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**VILLAGE DISTRICT OF ONCHAN (ROYAL TERRACE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) (BUS STOP) ORDER 2002**

Coming into Operation: 27th March 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 2 to the Act as required by Section 4A, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Village District of Onchan (Prohibition of Waiting) (Bus Stop) Order 2002 and shall come into operation on 27th March 2002.

Restriction of vehicles waiting

2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall, except upon direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the length of road specified in the Schedule.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the sides of the lengths of road referred to therein for so long as may be necessary to enable:-

(a) the vehicle if it cannot be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:-

- (i) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said sides of the length of road;
- (ii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said sides of the length of road of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity, or of any telecommunications apparatus (within the meaning of the Telecommunications Act 1984) kept or to be kept installed for the purposes of a telecommunications code system (within the meaning of that Act)
- (iii) the maintenance of such carriageway; or
- (iv) the repair in or near such road of any sewer, or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of any telecommunications system as defined in Section 2(3) of the Telecommunications Act 1986 (d).

- (b) to a vehicle being used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (c) to a vehicle being used in the service of a local authority in the pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (d) to a vehicle being used the purpose of delivery or collecting postal packets as defined in Section 58 of the Post Office Act 1993 (e);
- (e) to a vehicle waiting when the person in control of the vehicle :-
 - (i) required by law to stop;
 - (ii) is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident; or
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside his control.

Royal Terrace

- (i) Southside at its junction with King Edward Road at Port Jack for a distance of 19 metres fronting the existing bus shelter
- (ii) Northside from the wall northeast of the north eastern boundary of No 8 north eastwards for a distance of 19 metres
