CRIMINAL JUSTICE ACT 2001
**THE SEX OFFENDERS REGISTER
(PRESCRIBED FORMS) ORDER 2002**

Laid before Tynwald 16th April 2002
Coming into operation 4th March 2002

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Home Affairs by paragraph 1(2)(b) of Schedule 1 to the Criminal Justice Act 2001^(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Sex Offenders Register (Prescribed Forms) Order 2002 and shall, subject to paragraph 1(12) of Schedule 1 of the Criminal Justice Act 2001, come into operation on the 4th March 2002.

Prescribed form

2. The form set out in the Schedule shall have effect for the purposes of paragraph 1(2)(b) of Schedule 1 to the Criminal Justice Act 2001.

Prescribed Certificate of Caution

This notice contains a summary of the registration requirements you must comply with. It is not a complete statement of the law. If you need further advice you should consult an advocate.

To the person named below.

You have been cautioned for a sexual offence covered by Schedule 1 of The Criminal Justice Act, 2001. The details are set out in the certificate of caution at the end of the notice.

This means that you are now required by law to:

- **Notify the police within the next two days** of your name, any other names you use, your date of birth and your home address (i.e. your sole or main residence in the Isle of Man or, if you have no such residence, any premises in the Isle of Man you regularly visit.)
- **Notify the police within the next two days** of the nature and place of your employment, the name of your employer and business address.
- **Notify the police within the next two days** of any change of name, home address or employment details.
- **Notify the police within the next two days** of any address where you reside or stay longer than 14 days. This means either 14 days at a time, or a total of 14 days in any 12 month period.

You can give this notice either by going to your local Police Station and giving it in person or alternatively sending it to the local Police Station in writing. This applies even if you are already registered as a result of an earlier requirement.

These requirements apply to you for the next **five** years (2½ years if you are under eighteen years of age) starting from the date of your caution.

If you fail to comply with these requirements without reasonable excuse, or give the Police false information you could be fined or sent to prison for up to six months or both.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prescribes the form which requires persons cautioned for a sexual offence covered by Schedule 1 of the Criminal Justice Act 2001 to register with the police.
