THE DATA PROTECTION ACT 2002 (APPOINTED DAY) (NO. 1) ORDER 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Ministers by section 67(2) of the Data Protection Act 2002¹ and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the Data Protection Act 2002 (Appointed Day) (No. 1) Order 2003.

2. Commencement of the Act

The Data Protection Act 2002, except —

- (a) the provisions specified in paragraphs (a) to (e) of section 67(2), and
- (b) sections 51 and 57 and Schedule 9,

shall come into operation on the 1st April 2003.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order brings the Data Protection Act 2002 into force on the 1st April 2003, except the provisions which came into force on its passing, section 51 (prohibition on requiring job applicant to produce record of convictions), and section 57 and Schedule 9 (which relate to registers of electors and jurors' lists).
