THE DATA PROTECTION (CROWN APPOINTMENTS) ORDER 2003

Coming into operation

1st April 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Ministers by paragraph 4 of Schedule 7 to the Data Protection Act 2002¹ and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Isle of Man Data Protection Supervisor, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Data Protection (Crown Appointments) Order 2003 and, subject to section 61(1) of the Data Protection Act 2002, shall come into operation on the 1st April 2003.

2. Exemption from subject information provisions

Personal data processed for the purposes of assessing any person's suitability for any of the following offices are exempted from the subject information provisions of the Data Protection Act 2002 —

Offices to which appointments are made by Her Majesty:

Lieutenant-Governor
Bishop of Sodor and Man
First Deemster
Second Deemster
Attorney General
Incumbent of a benefice

Offices to which appointments are made by the Governor:

Archdeacon of Man

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order.)

This Order exempts from the "subject information provisions" of the Data Protection Act 2002 (under which data subjects are entitled to information about the processing of and access to their personal data) the processing of personal data for the purpose of assessing the suitability of a person for appointment to specified offices.
