THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT 2000 (AMENDMENT)  
ORDER 2003

*Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 1(6) of the Social Security Act 2000(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

**Citation, commencement and interpretation**

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Social Security Act 2000 (Amendment) Order 2003 and shall take effect from when it is approved by Tynwald.

(2) In this Order, "the Act" means the Social Security Act 2000.

**Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Act**

2. Schedule 1 to the Act (Acts of Parliament to which section 1 of the Act applies) shall be amended by the addition of the following entry at the end of the Schedule -

"2002 c.21 Tax Credits Act 2002".

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order)*

1. The Social Security Act 2000 ("the Act") enables the Department of Health and Social Security, by Order, to apply to the Island, as part of the law of the Island, subject to such exceptions, adaptations and modifications as may be specified in the Order, any legislation of the United Kingdom to which the Act applies.
2. The Act applies to the Acts of Parliament set out in Schedule 1 to the Act.
3. In accordance with section 1(6) of the Act, the Department may, by Order, amend that Schedule 1 by adding to it any Act of Parliament relating to social security passed during, or after, the 1998-1999 Session of Parliament.
4. This Order amends Schedule 1 by adding to it the Tax Credits Act 2002 (of Parliament) (Chapter 21).
