Coming into operation

1st April 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by section 3(2) of the Local Government (Entertainments) Act 1950¹ and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation commencement and interpretation

(1) This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Expenditure on Entertainments) Order 2003, and subject to section 3(3) of the Act, shall come into operation on 1st April 2004.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Local Government (Entertainments) Act 1950.

2. Variation of limit on expenditure

In relation to all local authorities, the amount specified in section 3(1) of the Act (limit on expenditure on entertainment etc.) is increased from 4p in the pound to 5p in the pound.

This Order increases from 4p to 5p in the £, the maximum rate which may be levied by a local authority for the purposes of section 3 of the Local Government (Entertainments) Act 1950 (improving or prolonging the visiting season, increasing its advantages as a resort, and providing public entertainments).
