**THE COPYRIGHT (CERTIFICATION OF LICENSING SCHEME)
(EDUCATIONAL RECORDING AGENCY LIMITED)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2003**

Coming into operation

1st April, 2003

Whereas by virtue of the Copyright (Certification of Licensing Scheme) (Educational Recording Agency Limited) Order 1993¹ (“the principal Order”) the Department of Trade and Industry (“the Department”) certified for the purposes of section 35 of the Copyright Act 1991² the licensing scheme set out in the Schedule to the principal Order, being a scheme operated by the Educational Recording Agency Limited;

And whereas the Educational Recording Agency Limited has applied to the Department for the principal Order to be amended in accordance with the Schedule to this Order;

In exercise of the powers conferred upon the Department by section 141(2) and (3) of the Copyright Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:—

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Copyright (Certification of Licensing Scheme) (Educational Recording Agency Limited) (Amendment) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on 1st April, 2003.

Amendment of Scheme

2. The licensing scheme set out in the Schedule to the principal Order is amended in accordance with the Schedule to this Order.

SCHEDULE

AMENDMENTS OF LICENSING SCHEME

1. For section 10 substitute —

“10. For licences taking effect on or after 1st April, 2003 the annual tariff, when calculated on a full-time and full-time equivalents per-capita basis by category of student in an educational establishment, shall be —

| (i) Students in primary educational establishments (including educational establishments known as preparatory schools) | 23p per capita |
| (ii) Students in secondary educational establishments | 47p per capita |
| (iii) Students in educational establishments of further education (including educational establishments formerly known as sixth form colleges) | 88p per capita |
| (iv) Students in educational establishments of higher education (including higher education colleges and universities) | £1.40 per capita |
| (v) Students in other educational establishments designated from time to time by the Department of Trade and Industry | a fee related to the above by type |

NOTE: Under the Licensing Scheme discounted rates below the above tariff may be negotiated covering large user groups and may form part of licences agreed to operate for more than one year.”
