



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (POLICE ACCESS ROAD)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2003**

Coming into Operation: 4th February 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Police Access Road) (Temporary Introduction of One-way System) Order 2003 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday 4th February 2003.

One-Way Traffic

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a south-easterly direction only over that section of the Police Access Road from its junction with the Police Station south-eastwards to its junction with Upper Dukes Road, Douglas.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Monday 19th May 2003 or until the road widening work is completed whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require traffic to proceed in a south-easterly direction only over a section of the Police Access Road in Douglas.

An alternative route will be via St Ninians traffic lights and Glencrutchery Road, Douglas.
