REGULATIONS 2003**

Coming into operation

21st March 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Isle of Man Gambling Control Commissioners by section 1(4) and (5) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:—

1. Citation and commencement

These Regulations may be cited as the Controlled Machines (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations 2003 and, subject to section 16 of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984, shall come into operation on the 21st March 2003.

2. Prescribed amounts

The amounts prescribed for the purposes of section 1(4) of the Gaming (Amendment) Act 1984 are —

- (a) for the purpose of section 1(4)(a) (maximum charge for play) —
 - (i) in the case of a prize machine, 30p;
 - (ii) in any other case, £2.00;
- (b) for the purpose of section 1(4)(c), (maximum prize), £25.00.


3. Revocation



EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations specify the maximum charge for play on amusement machines and the maximum prize payable on a "prize machine". The latter is increased from £15 to £25.
