



HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (CEDAR GROVE)  
(TEMPORARY CLOSURE) ORDER 2003**

*Coming into Operation: 21<sup>st</sup> February 2003*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a) and all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Cedar Grove) (Temporary Closure) Order 2003 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> February 2003.

**Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

2. Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform proceed or cause any vehicle to proceed on that section of Cedar Grove, Pulrose, from its junction with Laburnum Road to a point outside the properties No.32/34 Cedar Grove, Pulrose.

**Exemptions**

3. Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations :

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

(b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or

(c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or

- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or
- (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

**Duration**

4. The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> August 2003 or until the demolition work is completed whichever is the earlier.
