



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (DEVONSHIRE ROAD)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2003**

Coming into Operation: 17th February 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Devonshire Road) (Temporary Introduction of One-way System) Order 2003 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday 17th February 2003.

One-Way Traffic

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in an easterly direction only over Devonshire Road from its junction with Quarter Bridge Road to its junction with Ballabrooie Drive in the Borough of Douglas.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 22nd February 2003 or until the road resurfacing work is completed whichever is the earlier.

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require traffic to proceed in an easterly direction only over Devonshire Road in the Borough of Douglas.
