



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (QUARTER BRIDGE ROAD)  
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2003**

*Coming into Operation: 17<sup>th</sup> February 2003*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a) and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3 (1) the following Order is hereby made :-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Quarter Bridge Road) (Temporary Introduction of One-way System) Order 2003 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> February 2003.

**One-Way Traffic**

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a northerly direction only over that section of Quarter Bridge Road from its junction with the Quarter Bridge roundabout to Alexander Drive in the Borough of Douglas.

**Duration**

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2003 or until the road resurfacing work is completed whichever is the earlier.
