



## GAMING, BETTING AND LOTTERIES ACT 1988

### THE CROWN GREEN BOWLING FESTIVAL (No. 1) ORDER 2003

Coming into Operation: 9<sup>th</sup> June 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Isle of Man Gambling Control Commissioners by Section 25 (2) of the Gaming, Betting and Lotteries Act 1988 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:

#### Citation and Operation

1. This Order may be cited as the Crown Green Bowling Festival (No. 1) Order 2003 and shall come into operation on the 9<sup>th</sup> June 2003.

#### Temporary exemption for certain transactions

2. (1) During the period from the 9<sup>th</sup> to the 13<sup>th</sup> June 2003 sections 11, 14 and 15 of the Gaming, Betting and Lotteries Act 1988 shall not apply to the receiving or negotiating, at any of the places specified in paragraph (2), of bets on the result of a game or games of bowls at any of those places by a person who either -
  - (a) is the holder of a bookmaker's permit, or
  - (b) is the holder of a permit granted under Section 2 of the Betting, Gaming and Lotteries Act 1963 (an Act of Parliament) (b) and is approved in writing by the Commissioners for the purposes of this Order.
- (2) The places mentioned in paragraph (1) are the bowling greens at -
  - (a) Finch Hill, Douglas;


