THE BURIAL FEES RESOLUTION 2003

Coming into operation

1st February 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Ecclesiastical Committee of Tynwald by section 18 of the Burials Act 1986¹, and of all other enabling powers, it is hereby resolved as follows:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Resolution may be cited as the Burial Fees Resolution 2003 and shall come into operation on the 1st February 2003.
- (2) In this Resolution "burial" includes burial in a vault.

Burial fees

2. (1) The fees set out in the Schedule to this Resolution are prescribed as the fees payable in respect of burials in parish burial grounds.
- (2) Where there is no parish clerk or sexton, the fee otherwise payable to the parish clerk or sexton shall be payable to the person performing the duty in question.

Revocation

3. The Burial Fees Resolution 2002² is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Resolution.)

This Resolution fixes the fees payable in respect of burials in parish burial grounds. Under section 8(2) of the Cremation Act 1957 the same fee is payable for a funeral at a crematorium as for a funeral at a burial ground.
