Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 1 of the Social Security Act 2000(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (Application) (Amendment) Order 2003 and shall, subject to section 2(1) of the Social Security Act 2000, come into operation on 7th April 2003.

Amendment of the principal Order

2. (1) The Schedule to the Social Security Administration Act 1992 (Application) Order 1994(b) (which set out the Social Security Administration Act 1992(c) as it was to have effect in the Island) shall be amended in accordance with the following paragraph.

(2) In section 11(3)(b) (repeat claims), for the words from “he” to “or” there shall be substituted -

- “(i) he qualified under subsection (2) of section 129 of the Contributions and Benefits Act by virtue of paragraph (a) of that subsection; or
- (ii) he qualified under subsection (2C) of that section.”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order is consequential to another Order which amends the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 by adding another route by which persons may qualify for disability working allowance.

Article 2 of this Order ensures that those persons who originally qualified for disability working allowance via that new qualification route, but whose entitlement has now ended, shall automatically be treated as if they continue to satisfy the qualifying conditions for disability working allowance if they reclaim benefit within 8 weeks of their previous entitlement ending.
