



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**OLD CASTLETOWN ROAD (BRADDAN/SANTON)
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2003**

Coming into Operation: 18th March 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Old Castletown Road (Braddan/Santon) (Temporary Imposition of Speed Limit) Order 2003 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday 18th March 2003.

Temporary imposition of speed limit

2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 20 mph on that section of the Old Castletown Road from its junction with the A5 Douglas to Richmond Hill Road at Ellenbrook and a point 100 metres south-west of its junction with the B24 Oatlands Road, Santon.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 17th October 2003 or until the road surfacing work is completed whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

This Order effects the temporary imposition of a 20 mph speed limit on a section of the Old Castletown Road during re-surfacing works.
