



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**A5 DOUGLAS TO CASTLETOWN ROAD (SPRING VALLEY
ROUNDAABOUT TO PULROSE FARM COTTAGES) (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2003**

Coming into Operation: 25th March 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Douglas to Castletown (Spring Valley Roundabout to Pulrose Farm Cottages) (Douglas) (Temporary Imposition of Speed Limit) Order 2003 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday 25th March 2003.

Temporary imposition of speed limit

2. No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 20 mph on the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road from a point 250 metres south of the Spring Valley Roundabout to Pulrose Farm Cottages on New Castletown Road.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Sunday 14th September 2003 or until the road improvement work is completed whichever is the earlier.

This Order effects the temporary imposition of a 20 mph speed limit on a section of the A5 Douglas to Castletown Road in the Town of Douglas controlled by traffic signals.
