



FEES AND DUTIES ACT 1989

FEES AND DUTIES (GOVERNMENT FEES) ORDER 2004

Approved by Tynwald *16th March 2004*

Coming into operation *1st May 2004*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989 (a), and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Revocation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Fees and Duties (Government Fees) Order 2004 and, subject to section 1 (4) of the Fees and Duties Act 1989, shall come into operation on the 1st May 2004.

(2) The Fees and Duties (Government Fees) Order 2002 (b) is revoked.

Government Fees

2. The fees set out in the column 2 of the Schedule shall be taken in respect of the matters specified in column 1.

An affidavit, affirmation, declaration, or attestation, (but not a declaration of secrecy under rule 29 of the Election Rules contained in Schedule 2 to the Representation of the People Act 1995 (c) or a similar declaration made for the purposes of the election of members of a local authority) taken before a public officer.	2.60
4. Witnessing each exhibit to an affidavit, affirmation, declaration or attestation taken before a public officer.	1.60
5. Attesting or Legalising a signature and seal for Hague Convention countries and for the rest of the world.	12.00
