



THE PAYMENT OF MEMBERS' EXPENSES ACT 1989

THE MEMBERS OF TYNWALD (ANNUAL SUMS) ORDER 2004

Approved by Tynwald

21st January 2004

Coming into operation

1st January 2003

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by sections 1, 2 and 6(1) of the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the body designated for the purpose of section 6(3) of that Act, the following Order is hereby made:—

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Members of Tynwald (Annual Sums) Order 2003 and, subject to section 7(4) of the Act, shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st January 2003.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Payment of Members' Expenses Act 1989.

Annual payments to members of Tynwald

2. (1) Subject to paragraph (2), the annual sum prescribed for the purpose of section 1(1) of the Act (annual payments to members of Tynwald) shall be the amount that is equivalent in value to the mid point between the top spine point of the Higher Executive Officer Grade and the top spine point of the Executive Officer Grade of the Isle of Man Civil Service salary scales.

(2) In the case of a member holding an office specified in column 1 of Schedule 1, the annual sum is increased by the proportion specified in column 2 of that Schedule.

Annual payments to chairmen of Statutory Boards

3. The annual sum prescribed for the purpose of section 2(1) of the Act (annual payments to chairmen of Statutory Boards), in the case of the chairman of –

- (a) the Isle of Man Post Office,
- (b) the Isle of Man Water Authority, and
- (c) the Isle of Man Office of Fair Trading,

shall be an amount equal to one-tenth of the amount prescribed under article 2(1).

Revocation

4. The orders specified in Schedule 2 are revoked.


