

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

OLD CASTLETOWN ROAD (BRADDAN/DOUGLAS) (TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2004

Coming into Operation: 16th January 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 24 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Old Castletown Road (Braddan/Douglas) (Temporary Imposition of Speed Limit) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday 16th January 2004.

2. Temporary imposition of speed limit

No person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform cause any vehicle to travel at a speed in excess of 20 mph on that section of the Old Castletown Road from its junction with the A6 Douglas to Richmond Hill Road at Ellenbrook and a point 150 metres south-west of its junction with the A37 Marine Drive near Oakhill Bridge.

3. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Wednesday 30th April 2004 or until the road surfacing work is completed whichever is the earlier.
