THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT 2000

THE SOCIAL SECURITY ACT 2000 (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2004

Approved by Tynwald 19/02/ 2004

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 1(6) of the Social Security Act 2000(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Social Security Act 2000 (Amendment) Order 2004 and shall take effect from the day it is approved by Tynwald.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Social Security Act 2000.

Amendment of Schedule 1 to the Act

2. Amend the list of provisions of the Employment Act 2002 found in column 3 of Schedule 1 to the Act (Acts of Parliament or provisions of Acts of Parliament to which section 1 of the Act applies) by inserting the words "2, 4," after "Sections".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

1. The Social Security Act 2000 (an Act of Tynwald) enables the Department of Health and Social Security, by Order, to apply to the Island, as part of the law of the Island, subject to such exceptions, adaptations and modifications as may be specified in the Order, any legislation of the United Kingdom Parliament to which that Act applies.
2. The Social Security Act 2000 applies to Acts of the United Kingdom Parliament set out in Schedule 1 to it, which relate to social security matters (directly or indirectly).
3. In accordance with section 1(6) of the Social Security Act 2000, the Department may, by Order, amend Schedule 1 to that Act by adding to it any Act of the United Kingdom Parliament relating to social security passed during or after the 1998-1999 Session of Parliament.
4. This Order amends the entry relating to the Employment Act 2002 (an act of UK Parliament) by adding sections 2 and 4 to those provisions of that Act to which section 1 of the Social Security Act 2000 applies. Those sections provide for the payment of an adoption allowance or a paternity allowance by the DHSS to persons while they are on leave from their employment following the birth of a child or the adoption of a child or young person.
