(No. 4) ORDER 2004**

Coming into operation in accordance with Article 1

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Health and Social Security by section 1 of the Social Security Act 2000(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Social Security Legislation (Application) (No. 4) Order 2004 and shall, subject to section 2(1) of the Social Security Act 2000, come into force with effect from 1st March 2004.

Amendment of the Social Security Legislation (Application) Order 1997 (S.D. 41/97)

2. (1) Article 4 of the Social Security Legislation (Application) Order 1997(b) (which inserted regulation 51A (conditions for an additional payment for persons working 24 hours or more) into the Disability Working Allowance (General) Regulations 1991(c)) shall be amended in accordance with the following paragraph.

(2) In regulation 51A after “single claimant” insert “or a lone parent”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order, which shall come into force on 1st March 2004, amends the Disability Working Allowance (General) Regulations 1991 (as they have effect in the Island) by extending the availability of the additional allowance for employed earners who work for 24 hours or more a week to lone parents (it is already available to single persons and couples).
