



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (QUEENS PROMENADE)  
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2004**

*Coming into Operation: 30<sup>th</sup> January 2004*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Queens Promenade) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> January 2004.

**2. Temporary suspension of parking**

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on that section of the landward side of Queens Promenade, Douglas, fronting the Rutland Hotel.

**3. Duration**

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> April 2004 or until the building work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
