



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (PALACE ROAD)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2004**

*Coming into Operation: 10<sup>th</sup> February 2004*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act, as required by Section 3(1), and having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

**1. Citation, commencement and interpretation**

(1) This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Palace Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2004, and shall come into operation at 8.00 a.m. on Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> February 2004.

(2) In this Order –

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport.

**2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic**

Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of Palace Road, in the Borough of Douglas, between Empire Terrace/Castle Drive and its junction with, but not including, the former Falcon Cliff.

**3. Exemptions**

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations -

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

- (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;  
or
  - (c) in the service of the Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service; or
  - (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
  - (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

#### 4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> February 2004 or until the mains drainage connection works are completed, whichever is the earlier.

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along a section of Palace Road, in the Borough of Douglas, whilst mains drainage connection works are completed.
