



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

PARISH OF ARBORY (VARIOUS ROADS) (TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2004

Coming into Operation: 22nd February 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Parish of Arbory (Various Roads) (Temporary Weight Restriction) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on Sunday 22nd February 2004.

2. Temporary weight restriction

Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the maximum laden weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed on the following roads in the Parish of Arbory:-

- (i) A27 Colby Glen Road from Colby Glen Bridge to Earystane Road Junction
- (ii) B43 Ballagawne Road for the whole of its length
- (iii) B42 Ballabeg to Ronague Road from its junction with the Grenaby Road to Ronague Chapel.

3. Exemptions

Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used:-

- (i) in the course of duty for the emergency services;
- (ii) as a Public Service Vehicle;
- (iii) a Department of Transport vehicle;
- (iv) is displaying a permit issued by the Department.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to impose a temporary weight restriction of 7.5 tonnes laden weight on the following roads in the Parish of Arbory:-

- (i) A27 Colby Glen Road from Colby Bridge to Earystane Road Junction
- (ii) B43 Ballagawne Road for the whole of its length
- (iii) B42 Ballabeg to Ronague Road from its junction with the Grenaby Road to Ronague Chapel.
