



FEEES AND DUTIES ACT 1989

WORK PERMITS (FEES) ORDER 2004

Approved by Tynwald 16 March 2004

Coming into operation 1st April 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 1 of the Fees and Duties Act 1989¹ and all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:

1. Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as the Work Permits (Fees) Order 2004 and, subject to section 1(4) of the Fees and Duties Act 1989, shall come into operation on the 1st April 2004.

2. Fee on application for a work permit

A fee of £25 shall be payable to the Department of Trade and Industry on the making of an application for a permit under section 3 of the Control of Employment Act 1975².

3. Revocation

The Work Permits (Fees) Order 1994 is revoked³.
