**THE MATERNITY AND FUNERAL EXPENSES (GENERAL)
(ISLE OF MAN) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2004**

Approved by Tynwald 18th March 2004

Coming into operation in accordance with regulation 1

The Department of Health and Social Security, in exercise of the powers contained in section 138 of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992(a) (as it has effect in the Isle of Man), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:-

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) (Amendment) Regulations 2004 and shall come into operation on 12th April 2004.

Amendment of the Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) Regulations 2002 (S.D. 320/02)

2. (1) Amend the Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) Regulations 2002 in accordance with the following paragraphs.

(2) In regulation 10(2)(f) omit the word “and” at the end.

(3) After regulation 10(2)(f) insert –

“(fa) the cost of the Minister’s fee, subject to a maximum of £60;

(fb) the cost of the Organist’s fee, subject to a maximum of £35; and”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Maternity and Funeral Expenses (General) (Isle of Man) Regulations 2002 by providing that in respect of claims for additional funeral payments from 12th April 2004 allowances shall be made for the fees of a minister and an organist in addition to allowances payable in respect of other funeral costs. These allowances were previously included within the maximum allowance for funeral expenses.
