



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**UNNAMED ROAD ON NORTH-WEST SIDE OF QUEENS PLACE (PORT ST MARY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 19th February 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹ and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act, as required by Section 3(1), and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

(1) This Order may be cited as the Unnamed Road on North-West Side of Queens Place (Port St Mary) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2004, and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Thursday 19th February 2004.

(2) In this Order –

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport.

2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of the unnamed section of road on the north-west side of Queens Place, Port St Mary, between its junction with Queens Road and its junction with Athol Street.

3. Exemptions

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations -

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

(b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;

- (c) in the service of Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or
- (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Monday 3rd May 2004 or until the pipe work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along the unnamed road on the north-west side of Queens Place, Port St Mary, whilst pipe work takes place.
