



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**DROGHADFAYLE ROAD (PORT ERIN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 27th February 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹ and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) and after having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Droghadfayle Road (Port Erin) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday 27th February 2004.

2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed on that section of Droghadfayle Road, Port Erin, between its junction with Station Road and its junction with Athol Park/Erin Way.

3. Exemptions

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

- (1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations :
 - (a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;
 - (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;
 - or
 - (c) in the service of a local authority or the Department of Transport in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service; or

- (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department of Transport for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
- (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Saturday 13th March 2004 or until the services installation work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
(This note is not part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding on a section of Droghadfadyle Road, Port Erin, whilst services installation work takes place.

An alternative route for through traffic will be via Station Road, Strand Road and Athol Park.
