



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (THORNY ROAD/MURRAY'S ROAD)  
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2004**

*Coming into Operation: 13<sup>th</sup> February 2004*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985<sup>1</sup>, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

**1. Citation and commencement**

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Thorny Road/Murray's Road) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> February 2004.

**2. Temporary suspension of parking**

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on either side of the entire lengths of Thorny Road and Murray's Road, in the Borough of Douglas, between Bray Hill and Glen Falcon Road as indicated by signs.

**3. Duration**

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2004 or until the pipeline installation work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
