



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**VICARAGE ROAD (BRADDAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) (NO 2) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 28th February 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act, as required by Section 3(1), and having been satisfied that Section 1(8) of the Act does not apply, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation, commencement and interpretation

(1) This Order may be cited as the Vicarage Road (Braddan) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) (No 2) Order 2004, and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Saturday 28th February 2004.

(2) In this Order –

“the Act” means the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985; and

“the Department” means the Department of Transport.

2. Closure of road to vehicular traffic

Subject to Article 3, no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on that section of Vicarage Road, Braddan, between its junction with Saddle Road and its junction with Meadow Crescent.

3. Exemptions

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle requiring access to premises or land adjacent to the road specified in Article 2 or to -

(1) a vehicle engaged in any of the following operations -

(a) works in land or premises adjacent to the road specified in Article 2;

- (b) works in the road specified in Article 2 authorised by statutory provisions;
or
 - (c) in the service of the Department or a local authority in pursuance of any statutory functions in the road or in adjacent land or premises if it cannot conveniently be used for such purposes on any other road; or
- (2) a vehicle being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or other emergency service; or
 - (3) a vehicle for which the driver holds a permit issued by the Department for its use in the road, at a time or for a purpose specified in the permit; or
 - (4) such vehicular traffic as may be authorised by the Department.

4. Duration

The Order shall continue in force until Sunday 28th March 2004 or until the storm water pipe excavation work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding along that section of Vicarage Road between its junction with Saddle Road and its junction with Meadow Crescent, Braddan, whilst storm water pipe excavation work takes place.

An alternative route will be via Saddle Road, New Castletown Road and Cooil Road.
