



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (DEMESNE ROAD)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 27th February 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Demesne Road) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Friday 27th February 2004.

2. Temporary suspension of parking

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on both sides of Demesne Road from its junction with Bucks Road to its junction with the unnamed lane at the side of No 4 Demesne Road, Douglas.

3. Exemption

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle or vehicles:

- (i) being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service;
- (ii) such other vehicles as may be authorised by the Department of Transport.

4. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Friday 9th April 2004 or until the building work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
