



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**FINCH ROAD (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY DISABLED PERSONS' VEHICLES PARKING PLACE) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 5th March 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Finch Road (Douglas) (Temporary Disabled Persons' Vehicles Parking Place) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on the 5th March 2004.

2. Interpretation

“driver” in relation to a vehicle waiting in the parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.

“temporary parking place” means any part of the road authorised by this Order to be used as a temporary parking place.

3. Authorisation and use of temporary parking place

The part of the road specified in Column 1 of the Schedule may be used, subject to Article 4, as a temporary parking place solely for disabled persons' vehicles in such position on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that part of the road specified in the Schedule and indicated by the road markings specified in diagram 1028.3 and Traffic Signs 661 and 662 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 1994² as those Regulations have effect on the Island by virtue of the Traffic Signs (No 2) Regulations 1995³.

4. Other provisions

(1) The driver of a motor vehicle using the temporary parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in the temporary parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the temporary parking place.

(2) No person shall use any part of the temporary parking place for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from the temporary parking place.

(3) The Chief Constable may for good and sufficient reason prohibit the use of the temporary parking place during such time as may be reasonably necessary.

(4) The Department may suspend the use of the temporary parking place on giving notice of such seven days prior to such suspension.

5. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 5th August 2004 or until the building work on Finch Road is completed, whichever is the earlier.
