



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (WALPOLE AVENUE)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 4th March 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Walpole Avenue) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2004 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Thursday 4th March 2004.

2. Temporary suspension of parking

No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on both sides of Walpole Avenue, Douglas, from its junction with Loch Promenade to its junction with Bath Place.

3. Exemption

Article 2 does not apply to a vehicle or vehicles:

- (i) being used in the course of duty for the police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard service;
- (ii) such other vehicles as may be authorised by the Department of Transport.
- (iii) vehicles being used by Lloyd Morris Electrical or S. Craig & Sons in connection with the sewer pump station refurbishment work.

4. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Wednesday 10th March 2004 or until the sewer pump station work is completed, whichever is the earlier.
