



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (FORT STREET)
(TEMPORARY WIDTH/WEIGHT RESTRICTION) ORDER 2004**

Coming into Operation: 14th March 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985¹, and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made :-

1. Citation and commencement

This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Fort Street) (Temporary Width/Weight Restriction) Order 2004 and shall come into operation from 6.00 a.m. on Sunday 14th March 2004.

2. Temporary Height/Weight Restriction

Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the overall width of which exceeds 2.5 metres or the weight of which exceeds 3 tonnes to proceed along that section of Fort Street, Douglas, from its junction with Victoria Street to its junction with Lord Street.

3. Exemptions

Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used with the prior approval of the Department of Transport.

4. Duration

This Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on Sunday 25th April 2004.

EXPLANATORY NOTICE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to impose a temporary width restriction of 2.5 metres and a temporary weight restriction of 3 tonnes on a section of Fort Street, in the Borough of Douglas.

An alternative route will be via Victoria Street, Loch Promenade and Peveril Square, Douglas.
